The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to respondent No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the private respondents.

The matter came up for hearing on 08.04.2022 and the State of Punjab was directed to seek instructions in the matter.

Today on resumed hearing, short reply by way of affidavit of Amrik Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Bholath Kapurthala Jalandhar has been filed today in Court on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Copy thereof has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner. The relevant extract of the response is reproduced hereinbelow:-

“9) That there is no threat perception to the petitioner and answering respondent undertakes to provide adequate security to the petitioner in case petitioner apprehends any danger to her life.

10) That answering respondent has deployed PCR employees in the vicinity of the petitioner to thwart any threat to life of the petitioner by any of accused in present FIR.”

In view of the averments contained in the aforesaid affidavit, no further directions are required to be issued.

Disposed of accordingly.
