This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 47 dated 17.02.2021 under Section 285, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Chhapar, District Yamuna Nagar.
