Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondent Nos.4 to 8 from harassing or interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

It has been mentioned in the petition that petitioner No.1 is married with respondent No.6, however, on account of cruelty committed by her husband, she is now living with her free will with petitioner No.2. The petitioners have approached this Court for grant of protection as they have threat to their life. In this regard, they have also filed a representation, Annexure P-3, dated 28.03.2022, to respondent No.2, i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, Ludhiana.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Sakshi Bakshi, AAG, Punjab,

Heard.

In view of the prayer made in the petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, Ludhiana, to look into the representation, dated 28.03.2022, Annexure P-3 and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within one month from today.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of any law, if committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners.
