Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks a simple direction that respondent no. 1 be directed to decide his representation dated 25.02.2022 (copy Annexure P-9), with regard to the allotment of a flat in terms of the Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme, 2006, within a specified period.
