The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 222 dated 04.12.2020 under Sections 279 and 337 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

On 19.04.2021, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to issue notice of motion and also directed the parties to record their statements in support of the compromise. In pursuance of the same, the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh has submitted its report and as per the said report, in addition to respondent No. 2-complainant, there is one more person namely Manish S/o late Sh. Oliver, who had also sustained injuries in the incident and is, thus, a victim but he has neither

been impleaded as party nor has he appeared before the Court for getting his statement recorded in support of the compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after compromising the matter with all the victims/complainants.

In view of the same, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
