Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.22 dated 13.03.2022 under Sections 376 IPC, registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, Punjab.

Briefly, the FIR has been registered on the allegations that on 02.03.2022, at about 9:15 A.M., the prosecutrix along with her relative were consuming tea in the courtyard of the house and the petitioner had thrown pebble which hit her on the back. Subsequently, the petitioner along with his son Vishal came behind the house of the prosecutrix. Vishal inflicted brick blow on the head of the son of the prosecutrix. It has been further alleged that the petitioner had been forcibly making physical relations with the prosecutrix against her consent for the last about 4-5 years and was also having her objectionable photographs and video clips.

In terms of the order dated 12.04.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, interim bail was granted to the petitioner subject to the conditions as specified therein.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of the interim directions issued by this Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parjinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In these set of circumstances, order dated 12.04.2022 vide which the petitioner was granted interim bail is made absolute.

The petition is allowed accordingly.
