Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing respondent No. 1 to declare the result-cum-merit list of the petitioner as well as other candidates on the basis of an Advertisement dated 12.09.2016 (P-1).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied, in case, representation dated 19.03.2022 (P-6) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent-Subordinate Services Selection Board, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 19.03.2022 (P-6), in accordance with law by passing a reasoned order, within three weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
