The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct free and fair investigation after registering the FIR against the respondents No.4 to 13 and to protect life, liberty and property of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 to 13.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that post the preliminary inquiry conducted by the investigating agency, he is in receipt of further information under the RTI Act. However, the said issue of conflicting conclusions and the documents appended by the petitioner under the RTI Act cannot be gone into by this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative efficacious remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
