By way of present petition, the petitioner-complainant has sought issuance of direction to the Investigating Agency to decide the representation (Annexure P-1), pertaining to FIR No.150 dated 14.03.2018, registered under Sections 365, 506 IPC, at Police Station Quilla, District Panipat.

The reply dated 10.09.2018 was filed on behalf of respondents-State. In compliance of order dated 04.05.2022, the fresh status report has been filed. Para Nos.3 and 4 of the said report reads as under:-

“That during the course of investigation by ASI Dilbag, CIA-1, Panipat a representation No.695-Peshi Dt. 11/6/2018 (Annexure P1 already enclosed with the petition) was also presented by the peitioners alleging therein the allegations against Ramlakhan S/o Siyaram and Rajesh S/o Dataram and the said persons were joined in investigation and even the polygraph test of Rajesh was got done from the Forensic

Science Laboratory (H) Madhuban and the report thereof is already enclosed with earlier Status Report dated 26/11/2019 for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court but nothing incriminating evidence was brought on the police against anyone to arrest in this case so the said persons Ramlakhan S/o Siyaram and Rajesh S/o Dataram were also found innocent and no role in the crime so their names were left/deleted from the case.

That the petitioners have also not produced anything new information about the whereabouts of missing person Bishamber and the police has also not found any clue about his whereabouts, so keeping in view of the pendency of investigation since a long time, a closure report was prepared in the case on 22/06/2021 by the S.H.O., P.S. Quilla, Panipat with the plea that the investigation of the case will be re-opened on finding any clue about the whereabouts of the missing person Bishamber and intimation of the same was also given to the petitioners.”

After the closure report stands prepared, nothing survives in the present petition for adjudication at the hands of this Court.

Consequently, the instant petition stands dismissed.

However, needless to say that in case closure report is filed, the petitioner shall have the remedy before this Court.
