1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 20.08.2020, in CWP-12213-2020, in case titled as Parveen Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 20.08.2020, reveals that CWP-12213-2020, was disposed of by directing the Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, to decide the claim made in legal notice dated 21.12.2019, by passing a speaking order preferably within six months.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, has filed copy of speaking order dated 27.01.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in view of the claim of the petitioner made in legal notice dated 21.12.2019, having been rejected vide speaking order dated 27.01.2021, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be

permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated

27.01.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
