An oral request has been made by counsel for the petitioner for preponement of hearing of the main case, which is accepted.

Hearing of the main case is preponed from 17.11.2022 to today and it is ordered to be taken on Board.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 407, Cr.P.C., read with Section 482, Cr.P.C., for transfer of petition under Section 125, Cr.P.C., bearing MNT No.221 dated 23.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) titled as “Rajwinder Kaur Versus Malkeet Singh” filed by respondent, pending before learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Hoshiarpur Camp at Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

On the basis of prayer made in the application (CRM-23658-2022), counsel for the petitioner submits that matrimonial dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking divorce by mutual consent has been instituted. He seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the main petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In compliance of order dated 19.04.2022, the petitioner has deposited a Demand Draft bearing No.549752 dated 21.04.2022 drawn in the name of Rajwinder Kaur, respondent, which is lying with the Registry.
