The present writ petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 24.07.2019 (Anexure P/2), by which the salary of the petitioner has wrongly been fixed by granting him grade pay of Rs.2400/- w.e.f. 01.01.2006 instead of grade pay of Rs.3200/- by respondent No.3 .

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had already approached the respondent No.2 by filing a legal notice dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P/3) bringing to their notice that though, the salary of the petitioner was fixed w.e.f. 01.01.2006 on the grade pay of Rs.3200/- but the petitioner has been granted grade pay of Rs.2400/- while fixing salary by respondent No.3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present

in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P/3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in legal notice dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P/3), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P/3) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision of the legal notice, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of next four weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
