Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.22 dated 12.03.2022, registered for offences under Sections 306, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Satnampura, District Kapurthala Annexure P-4.

Mr. Anoop Verma, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.

Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Phagwara, Kapurthala has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied

to the counsel for the petitioner. State counsel has invited attention of this Court to para 11 of the status report, to submit that during investigation, it has been found that Balvir Kaur had committed suicide and no evidence has come on record against the petitioners. It has been further submitted that a cancellation report has been recommended to be submitted.

In view of the above development, counsel for the petitioners submits that the petition has become infructuous. He, however, seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the case with liberty to approach the Court again in case any cause of action arises.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
