In the present petition, primarily two prayers have been made. One is for quashing of the order dated 26.03.2019 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram (Annexure P-10) to the extent that the petitioner has been directed to surrender his passport on his return from Singapore.

The second prayer that has been made is for directing the trial Court to release the passport on account of the eye treatment of the petitioner which has been rescheduled for 13.04.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court that an application dated 28.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) has been filed for seeking directions for the permanent release of the passport of the accused and in the said application, at page-38 of the paperbook, it has been prayed that the accused be permitted to travel abroad and to Singapore.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to file an application before the trial Court with a prayer for permission to go abroad in which the medical condition of the petitioner would be detailed.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the said application would be filed by 11.04.2022 and has requested that the said application be decided as expeditiously as possible.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, moreso, the argument of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the medical condition of the eye of the petitioner is very serious, the trial Court is requested to decide the said application as expeditiously as possible.
