GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of cross-case registered vide Diary No.34 dated 21.01.2016 under Sections 452/427/379/506/323/148/149 IPC in FIR No.05 dated 21.01.2016 registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar City, under Sections 379-B/323/148/149 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise stated to have been effected between the parties.
2. Vide orders dated 01.06.2018, 02.05.2019 & 20.01.2020 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Separate reports of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, have been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of

accused/petitioners, namely, Satinder Pal Singh @ Honey Walia, Amritpal Singh, Balwinder Singh, Paramjit Singh Walia, Sweety and Navjot Singh @ Prince as well as of complainants Avinash Chawla, Samar and Kavita Chawla have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainants Avinash Chawla, Samar and Kavita Chawla in their statements have stated that they have no objection in case the DDR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and cross-case registered vide Diary No.34 dated 21.01.2016 under Sections 452/427/379/506/323/148/149 IPC in FIR No.05 dated 21.01.2016 registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar City, under Sections 379-B/323/148/149 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
