1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2, dated 21.01.2021, in CWP-21513-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-2, reveals that CWP-21513-2020, was disposed of vide order dated 21.01.2021, on the statement of learned counsel for the respondents that in case the claim of the petitioner seeking appointment on compassionate ground was still pending, the same would be examined, in accordance with law and as per relevant policy governing compassionate appointment and a final decision thereupon would be taken, as expeditiously as possible and in case within three months.

3. Learned Senior Standing Counsel for the respondents has placed on record copy of communication from respondent No.3, addressed to the petitioner, indicating the name of the petitioner in the

31.01.2021, in view of recommendation of the Committee constituted for appointment on compassionate grounds and at present the name was of the petitioner figuring at Sr. No.80 of the alive list for compassionate appointment submitted on 26.04.2022 and informing that the petitioner would be offered appointment to a Group-B post on his turn maturing as per seniority, subject to his fulfilling the eligibility criteria. The aforesaid communication is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
