This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to appoint the petitioners as Constable in Punjab Police in Category-C post.

The gist of the case is that the respondents acquired land belonging to the petitioners for the establishment of Peona Power Plant at Village Gobindpura and as per the Punjab Government policy decision dated 08.11.2011, one of the family members, whose land had been acquired, is to be given government job. The petitioners No.1 and 2 were appointed in Category-D post on 15.01.2015 and petitioner No.3 on 15.06.2018. The grievance of the petitioners is that on the date of appointment, similarly placed matric pass persons were appointed as Constables in Punjab Police under Category-C post, however, their claim was rejected.

At this stage, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners restricts his prayer for deciding the representations dated 15.03.2015

(Annexure P-18) made by petitioners No.1 and 2 and dated 19.10.2017 (Annexure P-10) made by petitioner No.3. He would submit that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the said representations are decided in a time bound manner.

At this stage, Mr. Pawan Sharda, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representations of the petitioners.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the representations dated 15.03.2015 (Annexure P-18) made by petitioners No.1 and 2 and dated 19.10.2017 (Annexure P-10) made by petitioner No.3. within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
