Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed for grant of parole to the petitioner for 4 weeks on account of the medical treatment of his father who is stated to be suffering from lung cancer.

Counsel submits that petitioner has been convicted and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment by the Addl.Sessions Judge, Gurugram on 19.04.2021 and his appeal is pending before this Court against the said conviction order. It is stated that father of the petitioner is suffering from lung cancer and requires treatment, while placing reliance upon documents in support as Annexures P-1 to P-5. The wife of the petitioner is stated to be working as a Teacher in KVS School at Udampur in Jammu & Kashmir and thus, there is no other person who is in a position to take care of his father who is undergoing chemotherapy etc.

Keeping in view the fact that representation dated 30.03.2022 (Annexure P-7) has already been preferred before the Superintendent of Jail, District Jail, Bhondsi, Gurugram for the said relief, this Court is of the opinion that the competent authority should take a decision on the said representation within a period of 2 weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the representation has not been received, let this petition be treated as representation and decision be taken within the aforesaid period.

Petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
