The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of a mandamus hence directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to give protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner, and against any interference in the peaceful life of the petitioner being made at the behest of respondents No. 5 to 8.
