[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 28.06.2021 in CWP No.10006 of 2021 in case titled as Satkartar Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.10006 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide legal notice-cum-representation dated 08.02.2021 moved by the petitioners in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG has produced speaking order dated 30.05.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioners. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the contempt petition and may be permitted to

withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 30.05.2022 by way appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
