MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.326 dated 04.08.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 365, 506 & 511 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 365 & 511, IPC deleted and Section 325, IPC added later on); Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 27 of the Arms Act deleted and Sections 54/59 of the Arms Act added later on), registered at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

This Court, on 20.03.2019, passed the following order:-

*“ Contends that CRM-M-4985 of 2019 by the co-accused
Samandeep Singh is pending for 01.05.2019.*

Notice of motion for 01.05.2019.

To be heard along with CRM-M-4985 of 2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contentends that in terms of the above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Surender Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 20.03.2019, petitioner has already joined the investigation and fully co-operating, thus, his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 20.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
