By this common order, this Court proposes to dispose of the above noted two writ petitions.

In fact, these two writ petitions had been filed seeking to challenge the final seniority list as circulated by the respondent-Board by virtue of which, *inter se* seniority of the petitioners, who were appointed against roster point for SC/Ex-Servicemen category had been changed with the seniority of respondents No.3 and 4, who belong to the general category.

Since the petitioners are withdrawing both the writ petitions, the law point as raised does not survive for adjudication by this Court.

Consequently, both the writ petitions are dismissed as withdrawn.

All the miscellaneous applications having rendered infructuous with the final disposal of the matter, are disposed of accordingly.
