In the petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No.4 to 9, who are relatives of petitioner No.1, on account of their marriage, which has taken place on 07.04.2022 as per Sikh Rites and ceremonies in Gurudwara Dashmesh Pita Patshahi Dasvi (Regd.) Village Singha Devi, Tehsil Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali). The marriage certificate and photographs have been appended as Annexures P-5 & P-6, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as per photocopy of their Aadhaar Cards and Matriculation Certificates (Annexures P-1 to P-4). A representation dated 07.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.S. Dhaliwal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State. Copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

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After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in ***Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478***, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.

In case there is any material concealment about any of the facts mentioned in the petition, it will be open to any of the parties to bring the same to the notice of this Court and then this order will be liable to be withdrawn.
