The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.82 dated 21.11.2020 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Women Police Station, Sector-17, Chandigarh.

By virtue of the order dated 20.8.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel appearing for the UT, Chandigarh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.8.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
