**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.05 dated 21.01.2016 registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar City, under Sections 379-B/323/148/149 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise stated to have been effected between the parties.
2. Vide orders dated 07.06.2018 & 02.05.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Separate reports of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, have been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Sunny Chawla and Samar as well as of

complainant Satinder Pal Singh @ Honey Walia have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Satinder Pal Singh @ Honey Walia in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.05 dated 21.01.2016 registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar City, under Sections 379-B/323/148/149 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
