The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial enquiry in the case FIR No. 31, dated 15.01.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 and 506 of the IPC and Section 3 (2) v (a) of SC/ST Act registered at Police Station Chandhut, District Palwal.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner inter alia contends that the investigation in the matter is not being expeditiously conducted by the Investigating Agency, compelling the petitioner to approach this Court.

Mr. Ashish Yadav, Additional A.G. Haryana is present in Court and has already been served with an advance copy of the petition states on instructions from Sub Inspector Manoj Kumar that the investigation in the case is already concluded and a final report has been prepared on 31.03.2022. He further states that final report shall be furnished before the Illaqa Magistrate expeditiously and preferably, after completion of all formalities, within a period of one month, in

accordance with law.

The statement is accepted.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the petition in view of the statement made by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State.

The petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage.
