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MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (Oral)

The petitioner herein has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to extend his parole for another period of six weeks, while averring that vide the order dated 11.03.2022 passed by this Court in ***CRWP No.1648 of 2022***, he was granted the relief of parole for a period of four weeks but he is suffering from several ailments and is still undergoing the treatment for the same.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for further extension of the period of parole of the petitioner while submitting that his (petitioner's) medical treatment is still continuing. However, no document or certificate has been placed on the file to substantiate the above-said fact. Even otherwise, a perusal of the file reveals that vide the orders dated 11.04.2022, 19.04.2022, 02.05.2022, 07.05.2022 and 19.05.2022 as passed

by the Co-ordinate Bench in the instant petition, the petitioner has been extended the concession of not surrendering in the Jail and the same virtually amounts to the extension of the period of his parole till this date which comes out to be more than six weeks as prayed for by him in this petition.

In view of the above-discussed facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that the petitioner does not deserve the relief of further extension of the period of his parole. It being so, the petition in hand stands dismissed and the petitioner, through his counsel, is directed to surrender before the jail authorities concerned tomorrow, i.e on 16.07.2022.
