Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that present petition has been filed by petitioner No.1 and legal heirs of Dharambir, who had also worked with the respondents-Sugar Mill for a period of more than 20 years but their gratuity has not been calculated in a manner required for as only 07 days salary for each year worked has been given to them as the gratuity whereas the same should have been for 15 days for every year completed. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that gratuity for which the petitioner No.1 and legal heirs of Dharambir are entitled for, has not been calculated in a correct manner, which is causing prejudice to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in legal notices dated 21.03.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively, which are

still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notices by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notices dated 21.03.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notices dated 21.03.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notices dated 21.03.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
