This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the candidature of the petitioner having applied for the post of Sub Inspector (Male) in Haryana Police in advertisement No.03/2021, dated 15.06.2021. It is contended that though the petitioner was successful and had secured sufficient marks to be offered appointment, the same was withheld on account of pendency of an FIR No.195, dated 25.06.2019, registered under Sections 120-B, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC at Police Station Asauda, District Jhajjar against the petitioner. It is pleaded that it is only on account of the pendency of FIR that the candidature of the petitioner is not being considered for the post of Sub-Inspector (Male).

Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the proceedings under the said FIR have now been stayed by this Court in CRM-M-19478 of 2022, which factor ought to be taken into consideration by respondent No.3. It is further submitted that the petitioner withdraws this writ petition and will approach the authorities concerned afresh and file a representation.

In view of the changed circumstances and the prayer made, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with an observation that in case the petitioner files a representation within a week from today, the same shall be considered by the respondents expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month thereafter.
