Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 22.02.2022, under Sections 304-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar, Punjab.

Vide order dated 12.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation and the State was directed to file status report which has been filed today in the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 12.04.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 12.04.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
