The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.39 dated 17.02.2022 registered under Sections 307, 498-A and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

By virtue of the order dated 18.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 18.04.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. He further submits that the parties have duly compromised the *inter se* dispute and the petitioner and complainant are living together.

Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court is also placed on record, which shows that though none of the parties appeared before the Mediation Centre, however, there are fair chances of an amicable settlement between the parties.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh has affirmed the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation. The Investigating Officer present in the Court has also informed that the parties have amicably settled the dispute.

In view of the above, the order dated 18.04.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
