By these petitions, the petitioners (in all petitions) seek the

concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR No.228, dated 18.11.2019, having been registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 454, 380 and 317 of the IPC.

As per report of the Registry, notice issued to respondent No.2 has been received back with the report that he has shifted to Chandigarh and therefore, he could not be served at the address given in the memo of parties.

In the reply filed on behalf of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to CRM-M-18497-2021, it has been stated that though the petitioners have joined investigation in the matter (as also are the instructions of State counsel from ASI Kulbir Singh), recovery of the gold chain, ear rings, gold ring as also Rs.1 lakh as are alleged to have been stolen by the petitioner, has to be recovered from them.

Without making any comment on the actual merit of the cases, these petitions are allowed, with the orders passed admitting the petitioners (in all petitions) to interim bail are made absolute.

However, it is again made clear that admitting the petitioners to bail does not reflect in any manner whatsoever, the opinion of this Court as regards the guilt of an offence of the petitioner which would be determined on the basis of evidence gathered and led before the competent court.
