Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 39 days
in filing the present appeal.

Keeping in view the facts mentioned in the application, the
same is allowed and the delay of 39 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

The application stands allowed.

Main case

The only contention raised by learned counsel for the
appellants/parents in seeking enhancement of compensation is that the
learned Tribunal has taken the income of the deceased, who was working as
Halwai to be that of unskilled labourer @ Rs.9000/- per month; whereas it
should be taken as of skilled labourer @ Rs.10,000/- per month. However,

no Notification pertinent to the relevant time as issued by the State Government has been brought to the notice of this Court by learned counsel in support of his contention.

No other ground has been raised by learned counsel for the appellants.

I find no ground is made out to interfere in the Award passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Faridkot, and the present appeal is hereby dismissed.

Pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
