Prayer in this writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ, direction or order especially in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner within a specified time.

The petitioner was recruited as Home Guard in the year 1991. However, on account of an FIR registered against him for using the certificate of another person having same particulars, he was dismissed from service. Vide representation dated 14.03.2022 (Annexure P-5), he is seeking reinstatement in service.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and would submit that the

respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.
