1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in CWP-18477-2021, in case titled as Balbir Singh vs. The State of Haryana and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-18477-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 31.08.2021, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and till the decision on the representation, no recovery was to be effected from the petitioner.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in the instant case.

4. However, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 02.05.2022, rejecting the representation submitted by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the

instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 02.05.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
