1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/6 dated 21.02.2022, in CWP-3235-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/6 dated 21.02.2022, reveals that CWP-3235-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 21.05.2021 as representation and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the benefits claimed and there was no impediment in grant of the same, release the same to the petitioner as per law without any delay.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to notice issued to respondent No.2 and 3, the respondents have decided the claim of the petitioner and released the benefits as per entitlement, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
