Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the FIR No.22 dated 7.7.2020, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women-1, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar alongwith all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail his remedy as available to him before the trial Court. He further prays for exemption from personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the petitioner files an application for exemption from her personal appearance before the trial Court and the trial Court is directed to consider the application moved by the petitioner for the grant of exemption from her personal appearance during trial subject to her filing affidavit to the following effect:-

1. That she will have no objection if the statements of witnesses are recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel.

- 2. That she will appear before the trial Court as & when required to do so by it.
- 3. That she will abide by any other condition imposed by the trial Court while granting her exemption from personal appearance.
