Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.32 dated 04.03.2022 registered under Sections 452, 323, 295, 427, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 307 and 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur ,who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of order dated 13.04.2022, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.
