1. Prayer made in the instant petition, for a mandamus being made upon the official respondents to hold fair, and, taint free investigation(s), into the petition FIR bearing No. 131 of 14.6.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad (West), District Fazilka, does not survive, as the learned State counsel, on instructions given to him by ASI Mukhtiar Singh, submits, that after conclusion of trial, upon the petition FIR, the learned trial Judge concerned, has proceeded to draw a verdict of acquittal, in respect thereof.

2. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as becoming rendered infructuous.

3. The verdict of acquittal, as made by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fazilka on 22.12.2021, upon the petition FIR, is placed, and, is taken on record.
