Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.28 dated 15.03.2021, under Sections 306 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar.

Vide order dated 23.04.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 23.04.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 23.04.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
