ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has come up before this Court for quashing of order dated 09.04.2022 whereby extension of parole, already granted to him by Superintendent of Prison, Central Prison-1, Hisar, which is going to expire on 13.04.2022, has been denied.

Notices served upon the official respondent(s) through the State's counsel.

Learned counsel for the State submits that once the parole has been granted then in such a situation petitioner must surrender and file fresh application for parole. There is no provision to extend the parole already granted.

Given the State's contention, since the parole is expiring tomorrow i.e. 13.04.2022, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Jail Authorities by 11:00 a.m. tomorrow and he will be permitted to make a fresh application for parole alongwith the reasons for the same.

Given above, the concerned Superintendent shall decide the fresh representation, if filed, sympathetically within two days. In case, the Superintendent dismisses the application for parole, it shall be accompanied by valid reasons.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case his grievance still exists.
