Present petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the order dated 01.04.2022 (Annexure P-14) by which, the petitioner has been transferred from Government Senior Secondary School, Morni Hills, District Panchkula to Government Senior Secondary School, Bitna, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is specially abled person (100% blind) and keeping in view the transfer policy in operation, the petitioner being specially able, should have been accommodated in District Panchkula itself as compared to a near by village. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the school, where the petitioner has been posted now vide impugned order, is just near to a over bridge and it is very difficult for the petitioner, who is 100% blind, to adjust himself and to cross the hurdles so as to reach school premises and will

need a helper throughout the day.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.K.S. Brar, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that though, the petitioner has been posted wherever the vacancy in the subject being taught by the petitioner was available but still, in case the petitioner makes any representation, the same will be sympathetically considered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be allowed to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.

The respondents authorities are requested that in case the petitioner files any representation, the same be considered sympathetically and all the efforts be made so as to post him, where he does not have to face inconveniences being specially abled person.

Let the appropriate order on the representation filed by the petitioner be passed within a period of two weeks from the receipt of the same.
