Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58 dated 26.02.2019 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 377 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat, District Sonipat (Annexure P-8).

Upon instructions from L/ASI Seema, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation in view of the compromise effected between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that as the FIR has arisen out of matrimonial dispute, which has been settled and by virtue of an order passed on even date in CRM-M-40036 of 2021, it has been quashed, instant petition has become infructuous.
