The petitioners have come up before this Court praying quashing of order dated 05.02.2021 vide which they have been declared as proclaimed offenders in complaint No. NACT/493/2018 as well as stay of the impugned order.

A perusal of the prayers reveal that petitioners are only challenging the proclamation order and not subsequent prayer.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing of the present petition, petitioner appeared before trial Court and he was enlarged on bail by the trial Court. He further submit that after that petitioner is appearing continuously before the trial Court and he is aggrieved of the order dated 05.02.2021.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is continuously appearing before the trial Court, the petition is allowed and proclamation order dated 05.02.2021, is set aside.
