LISA GILL, J.

Petitioner, who is an accused in FIR No.84 dated 16.03.2017 and FIR Nos.82 and 83 dated 01.04.2017, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Chipore, Kolkata (West Bengal), was afforded bail on 06.04.2021 by learned Additional Sessions Judge/Special Judge (PC Act) (CBI)-24, Rouse Avenue District Court, New Delhi, inter alia on the condition that petitioner shall not leave the country without the permission of the Court and would deposit his passport with the Court. Petitioner was thereafter granted permission to travel to Los Angeles, United States of America, for a period of 15 days, for the purpose of medical treatment, vide order dated 08.04.2022, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge/Special Judge (PC Act) (CBI)-24, Rouse Avenue District Court, New Delhi (Annexure P-8). Curiously petitioner has filed this petition before this Court seeking that records from the respondent relating to any

look-out circular by any agency or authority, which may have been issued against the petitioner, be called for and appropriate directions be issued that petitioner may not be restrained from travel abraod for the purpose of medical treatment.

Learned counsel for the respondent informs that a look-out circular has been issued.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
