Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Lovepreet Singh, Gurdeep Singh, Jagmeet Singh and Malkit Singh Fauji in criminal case having FIR No. 47 dated 02.03.2022 registered under Section 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 326 of IPC added later on at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioners submitted that the aforesaid petitioners have been falsely impleaded in the present case that there is also cross version as per which the opposite party caused grievous hurt to Jagdeep Singh @ Gogi and Malkit Singh Fauji. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that only simple injuries have been attributed to the present petitioners, who have already joined investigation with the Police by virtue of order dated 21.04.2022 passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh has not refuted the fact that the aforesaid petitioners have joined the investigation and that there is also cross version case registered against the opposite party for causing injuries to Jagdeep Singh @ Gogi and petitioner Malkit Singh Fauji. State counsel further submits that recoveries have already been effected from the present petitioners and they are not required by the Police for any further investigation.

The counsel for the complainant has resisted the present petition and submits that non-applicant Jadeep Singh @ Gogi caused grievous injury with the help of sword in furtherance of the common object of the present petitioners and as such present petitioners are not entitled to get concession of anticipatory bail.

As per the record no grievous injury has been attributed to the petitioners namely Lovepreet Singh, Gurdeep Singh @ Kesi, Jagmeet Singh @ Bhola and Malkit Singh Fauji who have already joined investigation with the Police and are not required by the Police for any further investigation as the recoveries have already been effected from them.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 21.04.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioners namely Lovepreet Singh, Gurdeep Singh @ Kesi, Jagmeet Singh @ Bhola and Malkit Singh Fauji should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
