Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is a lady with a minor daughter, had been transferred from Patiala where she was posted for over two years at her own request to Chandigarh vide order dated 04.04.2022 as her nine year old daughter is studying in Chandigarh, however, this order has been cancelled without any cogent reasons. He also submits that she shall be filing a representation before respondent No.2 for posting at Chandigarh or a nearby place and respondent No.2 be directed to consider the same sympathetically.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 that in the event of the petitioner preferring an application seeking her transfer to Chandigarh or a nearby place, the same shall be considered sympathetically in accordance with law within a period of fifteen days of its receipt.
