[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the appellant states that the matter has been amicable settled between the parties and the execution petition filed by the respondents has been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 21.08.2021 passed by the learned MACT, Rupnagar and that in the circumstances, the appellant is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn, while directing release of payment of Rs.25,000/- deposited by the appellant at the time of filing of the appeal.

[2] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the instant petition is *dismissed as withdrawn. Registry is directed to refund* amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited by the appellant.
