This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 25.11.2010 under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Mattour, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 18.04.2022 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State admits the above stated fact and contends on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation/interrogation.

In view of the stand taken by the learned State counsel, the order dated 18.04.2022 granting interim protection to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall also abide by the terms and conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
