Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.21 dated 20.04.2021, registered for offences under Sections 341, 354-A, 354-D, 323, 324, 34 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short "IPC") and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, however, later on Section 326, IPC was added, at Police Station Women, District Palwal, Haryana, Annexure P-2.

Upon instructions received from L/SI Vaneet and HC, Sunder, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation

pursuant to order dated 20.04.2022 passed by this Court and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. Still further, she submits that as recovery could not be effected from the petitioner, offence under Section 201, IPC has been added.

In view of the above, but without examining the merits of the case, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 20.04.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
